gone.

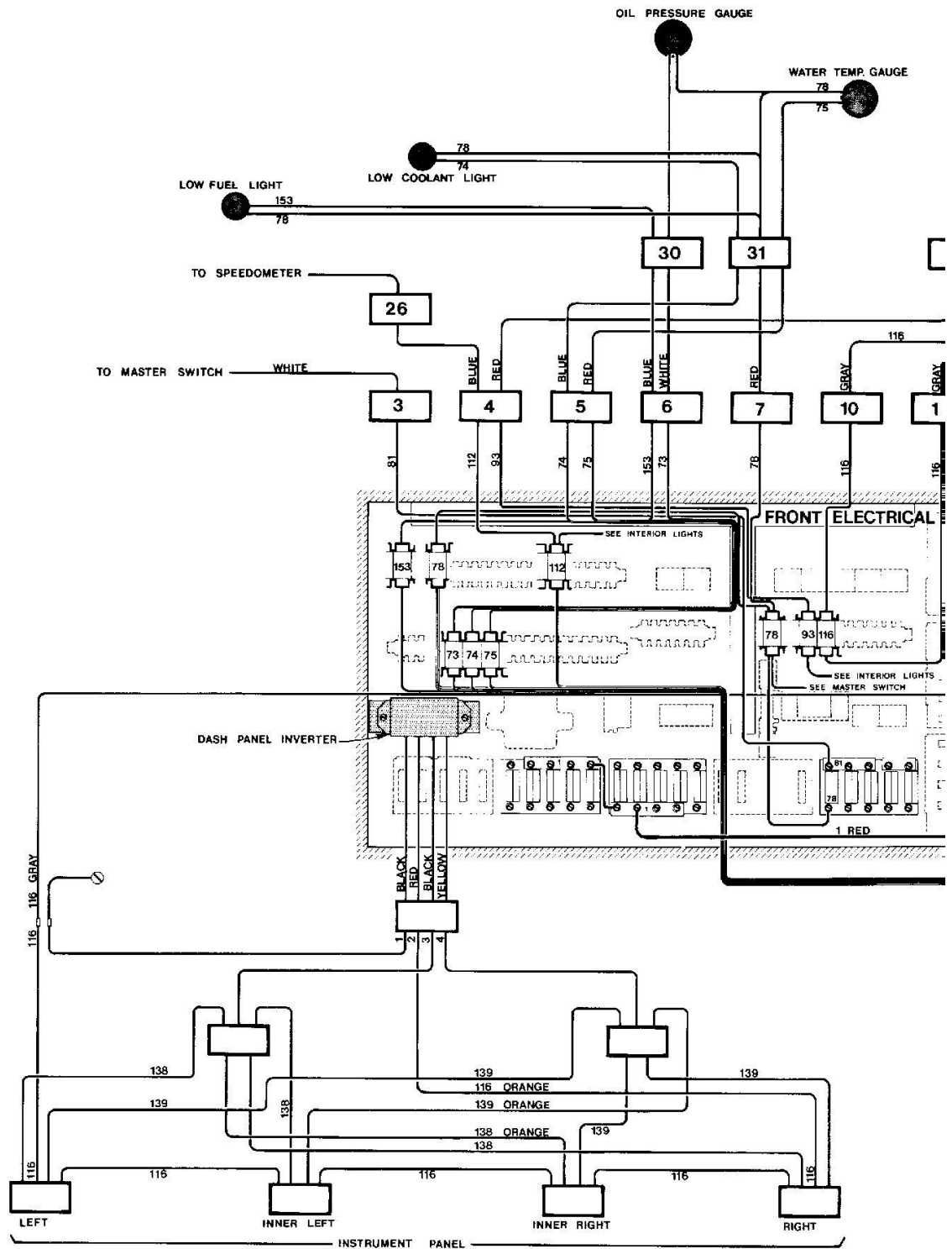
What will matter is not your memories of those
